This report provides detailed information on emerging markets according to buy-side firms located in North America investing in U.S. fixed income. Research is based on in-person and telephone interviews with 62 emerging markets investors in the 2018 Study. The data in this report is based upon aggregated results from individuals participating in the study.



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
