Executive Summary:

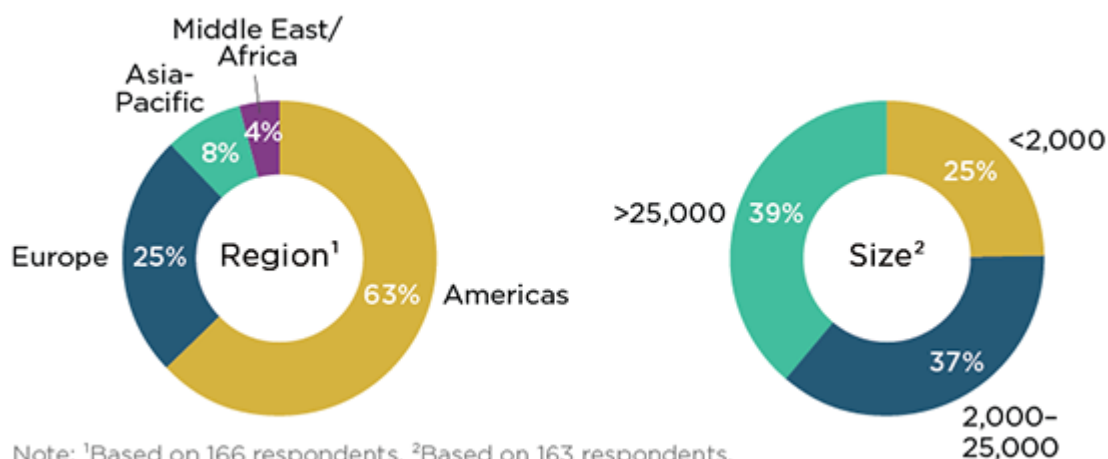
