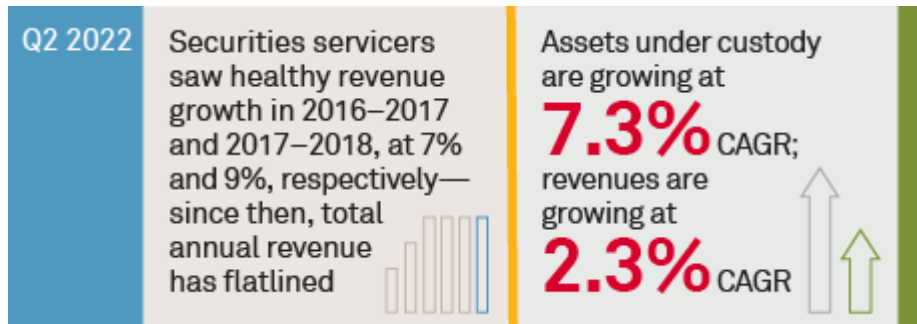


# Securities Servicers Enter Pivotal Year of Change
