Executive Summary:

This report provides detailed information on Asian trade finance, including insights from corporate treasury professionals on digital adoption, top banks considered distinctive in providing advice, data on ESG targets, and more.

Methodology:

Between April to July 2023, Coalition Greenwich conducted 514 interviews with corporates with annual revenues of \$500 million or more across China, Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Singapore, South Korea, Taiwan, Thailand, Macau and Vietnam.
