

# 2024 Highlights on Infrastructure Investing Trends

## 2024 Global Institutional Investors Study

### Executive Summary:

This report covers the latest trends in infrastructure investing based on feedback with influential asset owners. Coalition Greenwich gathered their views of the current infrastructure landscape, including differentiators, impediments, approaches, strategies, and capabilities of an asset manager.

### Methodology:

In 2024, Coalition Greenwich undertook a study with institutional investors to assess the latest trends in Infrastructure investing. Globally, we interviewed 379 institutional investors between February and July 2024.



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
