

2014 Equity Derivatives - North America

Executive Summary:

This report provides detailed information from North America-based investors investing in equity derivatives, including helpful benchmark data such as:

- Product usage
- Important selection criteria
- Concentration of business
- Notional trading value

Methodology:

Research is based on in-person and telephone interviews with 173 respondents between May and June, 2014. The data in this report is based upon aggregated results from individuals participating in the study.

Buy-side institutional investors were asked to provide quantitative and qualitative evaluations of the broker-dealers they use as well as detailed information on important market trends.



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
