Executive Summary:

This report provides detailed information from institutional investors in the U.S. on fees paid to investment management services.

Methodology:

Greenwich Associates' 46th annual research with U.S. Institutional Investors is based on in-depth interviews conducted primarily through in-person interviews, and supplemented by telephone interviews and online surveys, between July and October of 2017.



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
