This report provides market trends for European large corporates regarding their banking preferences, products and credit usage, time allocation for treasury professionals, and treasury performance metrics.

Methodology:

This report provides bank relationship information for banking gathered from treasury professionals across Europe. Research is based on in-person and telephone interviews with corporates with annual revenues of at least Eur\$2B. Interviews take place from August thru November annually.



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
